FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR RESNER

<u>277</u> - that's how many people were in church last Sunday! It was not a Church Holiday or special service, but 277 were in attendance. In many places, Churches are struggling to keep the 'doors open'. There are many Churches without children attending. There is a shortage of pastors as well. We are SO blessed to have such a wonderful place to worship and be together with God's people Sunday after Sunday.

With that said, we must look to our future and plan for the next generation. We are learning in our Adult Bible Class how to 'Pass It On' (the faith) - to tell the next generation about the love of Jesus. This is certainly an exciting time for our Church as we plan for our children so that they may be raised in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. God Bless us as together we strive to serve Him in this place.

PREPARING FOR CHURCH THIS SUNDAY

Today is the last Sunday before Lent. In the Western Church today is known as *Quinquagesima*, which is a really fancy way of saying fifty. Easter is fifty days from today. The more common church lectionaries call today Transfiguration Sunday since Church tradition holds that the Transfiguration is read in the Gospel reading for this Sunday. The Transfiguration is when Jesus took Peter, James, and John up to the top of a mountain and His appearance changed. In what we call His state of humiliation (from His conception through His death), Jesus looked like an ordinary human man. But on this mountain, His appearance changed to show His glory and radiance. Moses and Elijah also appear alongside Jesus. Jesus gives us a sort of sneak peek into His state of exaltation, His glory, and His resurrection. Peter, James, and John must have been quite surprised at seeing this and the awe of being in the presence of God. No wonder that Peter wants to stay there and not come down off this mountain. Mountain top experiences can be quite powerful and exhilarating, so much so that coming down from the mountain sometimes leaves us empty, sad, or even depressed. But God the Father gives us the solution to our human weakness - He says, "Listen to Him."


Men's Bible Study


