PREPARING FOR CHURCH THIS SUNDAY

The Gospel of Mark is a Gospel of action. More than any of the other three Gospels, Mark shows Jesus in action. Along with this action, Mark seems to be showing a sense of urgency to the ministry of Jesus. He uses the word 'immediately' quite often to portray this sense of urgency. And Mark's Gospel starts abruptly with the appearance of John the Baptizer and ends more abruptly, leaving us at the empty tomb with terrified women. (Early manuscripts end at 16:8)

In today's reading, Jesus says, "Repent and believe the Gospel - NOW!" When He calls His first disciples, they 'immediately' leave their boats and follow Him. And Jesus tells these men, "I will make you fishers of men."

PART TIME PRESCHOOL AIDE NEEDED


