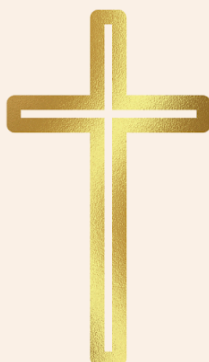
Children's Sunday School
