FROM THE DESK OF YOUTH & FAMILY MINISTRY

I was recently reading an article entitled Three Reasons to Bring Your Bible To Church by Craig McCourt, and it reminded me, once again, how precious God’s written Word is. I love holding it in my hands. I love reading and meditating on it. I love sharing it. I love that the whole book is one story that points to God’s amazing love for you and me.

Of course, there is no rule about bringing your Bible to church with you. In fact, there is one in each pew. But maybe bringing **your** Bible to worship might bring you into a deeper understanding of God’s word. Since it is Trinity Sunday, I thought I would summarize and add some thoughts to the article’s three reasons for bringing **your** Bible to church.

1. Having God’s Word in your hands is always a good thing! It is a great way to model to the children (and adults) around you of its importance.
2. Having God’s Word in your hands allows you to fit the readings for the week into the bigger context of God’s Word. When we see the bigger picture, God’s Word is easier to understand.
3. Having God’s Word in your hands allows you to write notes and thoughts for later. I have often quoted pastors in the margin, linked the verse with another reference, underlined, highlighted, or even drawn a picture to help me make a connection. I hope to pass my messy marked up Bible to the next generation as a reminder that in the Word, my messy marked up self, finds forgiveness, life, and joy!

So, consider beginning this new habit this summer. May you be blessed as you and your family abide in God’s Word.

John 8:31-32 So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in Him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

PART TIME 7/8 GRADE TEACHING POSITION

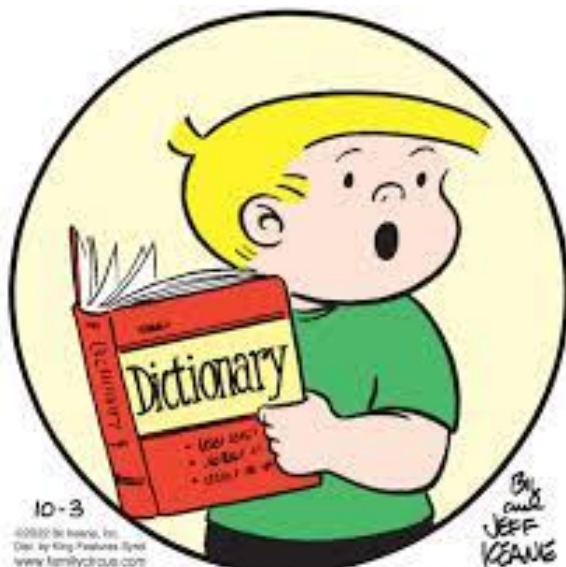
