FROM THE DESK OF MR. KOPP

With cold weather back in the forecast, it might be a good time to send out this reminder about snow days. You might be wondering how I know what to do or where to look. We have two main ways to communicate if school or preschool has either closed or will do a 2-hour delay. You can tune into KRCG 13 on your tv or check their website to see if we have closed or delayed. We will also do a robocall to all numbers that we have on file for the school. If your number has changed please contact the school office to update your information. I try to make this decision by 6 am, but sometimes it happens later due to changing conditions.

What is the difference between closing and a 2-hour delay? When we close, we are closed for the day and the school will not offer any services. If we delay, the school will open 2 hours later, but the day will still end at 3. For a 2 hour delay, before school care will open at 9:00 am and lunch still will be served at the same time. The preschool will open its doors at 9:00 am and close at their normal time. Overall, the school day and preschool day run normal, just that we start 2 hours into the day.

What can I do as a parent to prepare? Snow days happen and for the most part they are never convenient. As a parent, please have a plan in place for both situations that could occur. Please make a plan in case we close for the day and another plan if we have a 2-hour delay. There also might be times that we do not close, but you feel the roads are unsafe. As a parent you have the full right to call the school and let us know that your child(ren) will not be in school that day. Also, if you feel the roads are getting bad during the school day you have the right to pull your child before the end of the day. In either case, we will count this as an excused absence.

PREPARING FOR CHURCH THIS SUNDAY

This Sunday, the second Sunday in Advent, we light the "Bethlehem Candle". This candle symbolizes 'peace'. This peace is not the kind of peace the world thinks about. It is the peace of God that passes all human understanding. It is the peace that Christ came to bring. It is the peace of which the angels sang. It is the peace that reconciles God and sinner.

Christ came to redeem us. He came to restore fallen Creation. He came to take away our sin and shame. He came to bring peace for us with the Father. This is the comfort the prophet Isaiah was speaking about in today's Old Testament reading.





THE ADVENT WREATH

Year after year, we light the Advent wreath in Church. But do we do this only out of habit or tradition? Did you know that each candle has significance and meaning? And there is a specific order to the lighting of the candles.

The *first candle* is purple or blue and is called the '<u>Prophet's Candle</u>'. It signifies <u>HOPE</u>. The first Sunday in Advent leads us to anticipate the birth of Christ, but also to celebrate a new beginning - a new Church Year and a new liturgical season. Christ brings *hope* to the world as prophesied by Isaiah's foretelling and Christ's fulfilment of all the Old Testament prophecies.

The *second candle* is also purple or blue and is called the '<u>Bethlehem Candle</u>'. It signifies <u>PEACE</u>. This candle reminds us of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. Building off the meaning of the Prophecy Candle, Jesus has come to bring peace by reconciling us with God the Father.

The *third candle* is pink or rose colored and is called the '<u>Shepherd's Candle</u>'. It signifies <u>JOY</u>! As the shepherd's were told by the angel, "I bring you *GOOD NEWS* of great JOY!" The third Sunday in Advent is also known as "Gaudete Sunday", which means rejoice or praise. We, too, like the shepherds, should rejoice for everything we see and hear about Christ.

The *fourth candle* is purple or blue and is called the '<u>Angel's Candle</u>'. It signifies <u>LOVE</u>. We eagerly await the birth of Christ as God has truly sent us His Love in Christ at Christmas.

The *fifth candle*, placed in the center of the wreath, is white and is called the <u>Christ Candle</u>. It signifies the purity and holiness of Christ. On *Christmas Eve*, we will light our candles from the Christ Candle. This signifies that, as Christ is the 'Light of the world', He comes to us and lights our hearts with faith in Him. And as we light our candles, we are reminded to share His love with others.
