PREPARING FOR CHURCH THIS SUNDAY

Palm Sunday is the celebration of the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. The people lay down their cloaks and wave palm branches as they shout and sing, “Hosanna”. Hosanna derives from a Hebrew word meaning “God save us”. The palm branch is a symbol of freedom and national pride much like our flag. As the people are waving their branches and singing, they are welcoming the Messiah whom they thought would overthrow Rome and deliver them from their earthly oppressors. But Jesus came to deliver us from our spiritual oppressors of sin, death, and the devil. Soon, these same people will be calling out, “Crucify Him!”.

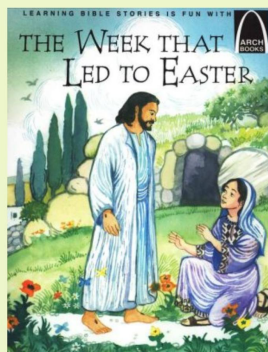

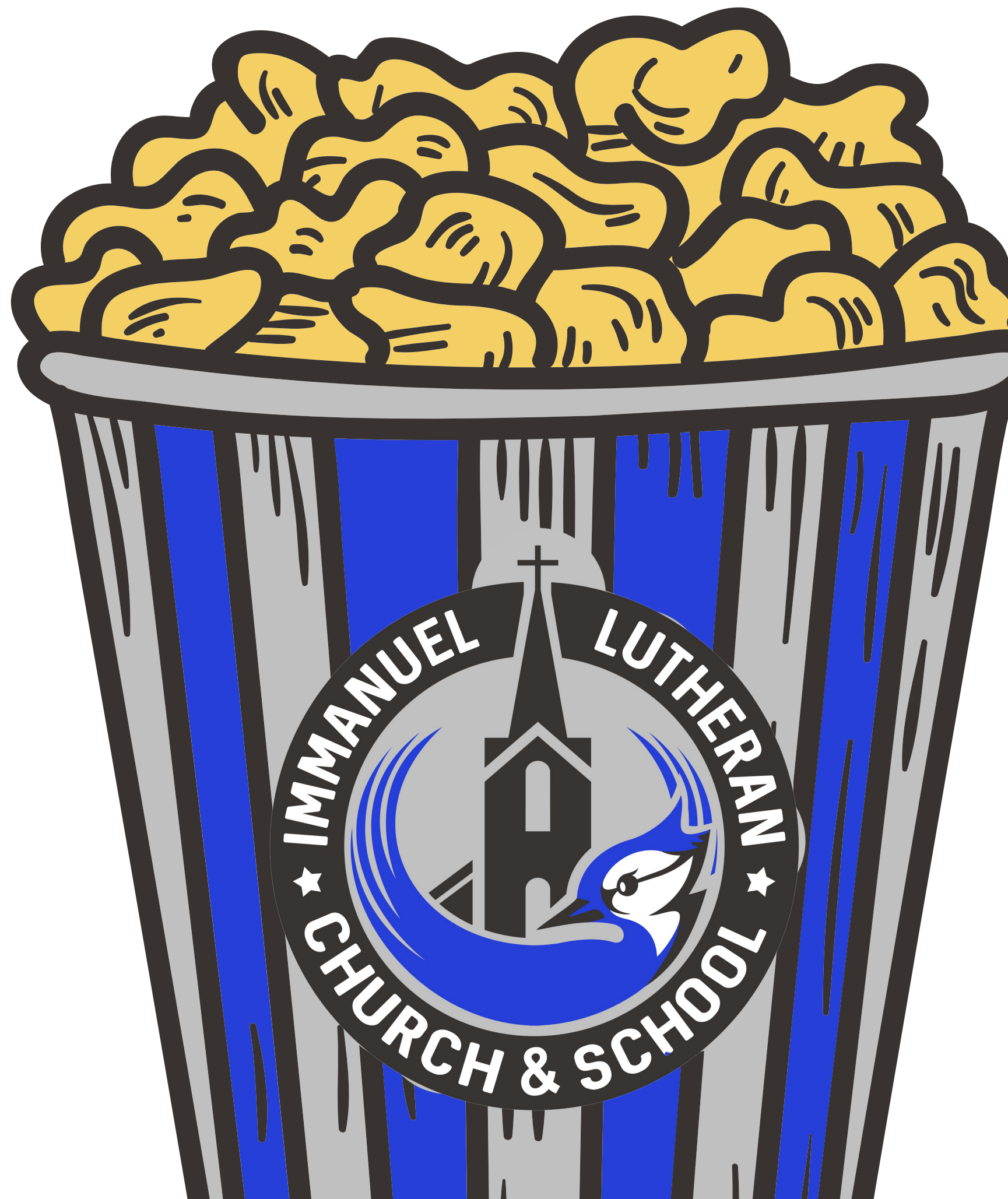
